# MORNING



## PSALM 123

*Prayer for Relief from Oppression*

<sup>1</sup> Unto You I lift up my eyes,

O You who dwell in the heavens.

<sup>2</sup> Behold,

as the eyes of servants

*look* to the hand of their masters,

as the eyes of a maid to the hand of her mistress,

so our eyes *look* to Jesus Christ our God,

until He has mercy on us.

<sup>3</sup> Have mercy on us, O Jesus Christ, have mercy on us!

for we are exceedingly filled with contempt.

<sup>4</sup> Our soul is exceedingly filled

with the scorn of those who are at ease,

with the contempt of the proud.



# MORNING



## PSALM 125

*Jesus Christ the Strength of His People*

<sup>1</sup> Those who trust in Jesus Christ *are* like Mount Zion,  
which cannot be moved, *but* abides forever.

<sup>2</sup> As the mountains surround Jerusalem,  
so Jesus Christ surrounds His people  
from this time forth and forever.

<sup>3</sup> For the scepter of wickedness shall not rest  
on the land allotted to the righteous,  
lest the righteous reach out their hands to iniquity.

<sup>4</sup> Do good, O Jesus Christ, to *those who are* good,  
and to *those who are* upright in their hearts.

<sup>5</sup> As for such as turn aside to their crooked ways,  
Jesus Christ shall lead them away  
with the workers of iniquity.

Peace *be* upon Israel!



# MORNING



## PSALM 127

*Laboring and Prospering with Jesus Christ*

- <sup>1</sup> Unless Jesus Christ builds the house,  
they labor in vain who build it;  
Unless Jesus Christ guards the city,  
the watchman stays awake in vain.
- <sup>2</sup> *It is vain for you to rise up early,  
to sit up late, to eat the bread of sorrows;  
for so He gives His beloved sleep.*
- <sup>3</sup> Behold, children *are* a heritage from Jesus Christ,  
the fruit of the womb is a reward.
- <sup>4</sup> Like arrows in the hand of a warrior,  
so *are* the children of one's youth.
- <sup>5</sup> Happy *is* the man who has his quiver full of them;  
They shall not be ashamed,  
but shall speak with their enemies in the gate.



# MID-DAY



## PSALM 124

*Jesus Christ the Defense of His People*

<sup>1</sup>“If it had not been Jesus Christ who was on our side,”  
let Israel now say –

<sup>2</sup>“If it had not been Jesus Christ who was on our side,”  
when men rose up against us,

<sup>3</sup> Then they would have swallowed us alive,  
when their wrath was kindled against us;

<sup>4</sup> Then the waters would have overwhelmed us,  
the stream would have gone over our soul;

<sup>5</sup> Then the swollen waters would have gone over our  
soul.”

<sup>6</sup> Blessed *be* Jesus Christ,  
who has not given us *as* prey to their teeth.

<sup>7</sup> Our soul has escaped  
as a bird from the snare of the fowlers;  
The snare is broken, and we have escaped.

<sup>8</sup> Our help *is* in the name of Jesus Christ,  
Who made heaven and earth.



# MID-DAY



## PSALM 129

*Song of Victory over Jesus Christ's Enemies*

- <sup>1</sup> “Many a time they have afflicted me from my youth,”  
let Israel now say –
- <sup>2</sup> “Many a time they have afflicted me from my youth,  
yet they have not prevailed against me.
- <sup>3</sup> The plowers plowed on my back;  
They made their furrows long.”
- <sup>4</sup> Jesus Christ *is* righteous;  
He has cut in pieces the cords of the wicked.
  
- <sup>5</sup> Let all those who hate Zion  
be put to shame and turned back.
- <sup>6</sup> Let them be as grass *on* the housetops,  
which withers before it grows up,
- <sup>7</sup> With which the reaper does not fill his hand,  
nor he who binds sheaves, his arms.
- <sup>8</sup> Neither let those who pass by them say,  
“The blessing of Jesus Christ *be* upon you;  
We bless you in the name of the Jesus Christ!”



# VESPERS



## PSALM 126

*A Joyful Return of Jesus Christ's People*

<sup>1</sup> When Jesus Christ brought back the captivity of Zion,  
we were like those who dream.

<sup>2</sup> Then our mouth was filled with laughter,  
and our tongue with singing.  
Then they said among the nations,  
“Jesus Christ has done great things for them.”

<sup>3</sup> Jesus Christ has done great things for us,  
*and* we are glad.

<sup>4</sup> Bring back our captivity, O Jesus Christ,  
as the streams in the South.

<sup>5</sup> Those who sow in tears shall reap in joy.

<sup>6</sup> He who continually goes forth weeping,  
bearing seed for sowing,  
shall doubtless come again with rejoicing,  
bringing his sheaves *with him*.



# VESPERS



## PSALM 128

*Blessings of Those Who Fear Jesus Christ*

- <sup>1</sup> Blessed *is* every one who fears Jesus Christ,  
who walks in His ways.
- <sup>2</sup> When you eat the labor of your hands,  
you *shall be* happy,  
and *it shall be* well with you.
- <sup>3</sup> Your wife *shall be* like a fruitful vine  
in the very heart of your house,  
Your children like olive plants  
all around your table.
- <sup>4</sup> Behold, thus shall the man be blessed  
who fears Jesus Christ.
- <sup>5</sup> Jesus Christ bless you out of Zion,  
and may you see the good of Jerusalem  
all the days of your life.
- <sup>6</sup> Yes, may you see your children's children.  
Peace *be* upon Israel!



# EVENING



## PSALM 130

*Waiting for the Redemption of Jesus Christ*

<sup>1</sup> Out of the depths I have cried to You, O Jesus Christ.

<sup>2</sup> Lord, hear my voice! Let Your ears be attentive  
to the voice of my supplications.

<sup>3</sup> If You, Jesus Christ, should mark iniquities  
O Lord, who could stand?

<sup>4</sup> But *there is* forgiveness with You,  
that You may be feared.

<sup>5</sup> I wait for Jesus Christ, my soul waits,  
and in His word I do hope.

<sup>6</sup> My soul *waits* for the Lord  
more than those who watch for the morning –  
*Yes, more than* those who watch for the morning.

<sup>7</sup> O Israel, hope in Jesus Christ;  
for with Jesus Christ *there is* mercy,  
and with Him *is* abundant redemption.

<sup>8</sup> And He shall redeem Israel from all his iniquities.



# EVENING



## PSALM 131

*Simple Trust in Jesus Christ*

- <sup>1</sup> Jesus Christ, my heart is not haughty,  
nor my eyes lofty.  
Neither do I concern myself  
with great matters,  
nor with things too profound for me.
- <sup>2</sup> Surely I have calmed and quieted my soul,  
like a weaned child with his mother;  
like a weaned child *is* my soul within me.
- <sup>3</sup> O Israel, hope in Jesus Christ  
from this time forth and forever.

*Is this required at all times?*


No. We are not practitioners of Judaism.




## **PONDER A PROVERB DAILY.**


*How might one do that?*




## THE APOSTLE'S CREED


I believe in God, the Father Almighty,

and the life everlasting. Amen.






## THE LORD'S PRAYER

You shall not steal.


You shall not give false testimony against your neighbor.
